## LA CLIPPERS ACQUIRE GIANNIS ANTETOKOUNMPO AND JAMAREE BOUYEA FROM MILWAUKEE

**LOS ANGELES** – The LA Clippers have acquired forward Giannis Antetokounmpo and guard Jamaree Bouyea from the Milwaukee Bucks in exchange for forward Trentyn Flowers, guard Cam Christie, forward Kobe Brown, and three future first-round draft selections (2028, 2029, and a lottery-protected 2031).

Antetokounmpo, a two-time NBA Most Valuable Player (2019, 2020) and 2021 NBA Finals MVP, spent his entire 12-year career with Milwaukee. The seven-time All-Star is averaging 28.1 points, 11.3 rebounds, and 5.8 assists per game this season while shooting 60.4% from the field. The 30-year-old forward was named to the NBA's All-Defensive First Team five times and the All-NBA First Team seven times.

“Adding Giannis, one of the most dominant players in the game, is an extraordinary moment for our organization,” said Clippers President of Basketball Operations Lawrence Frank. “He brings leadership, versatility, and championship experience that will elevate our team on both ends of the court; and bring home playoff contention. We are equally excited to welcome Jamaree, who has shown great poise and toughness in his early opportunities at the NBA level.”

Bouyea, 25, has appeared in 18 games for Milwaukee this season, averaging 4.2 points and 2.1 assists in 12.5 minutes per contest. The California native starred at the University of San Francisco, where he became the program's all-time leader in games played and was twice named First Team All-WCC. After going undrafted in 2022, he earned his way into the NBA through strong performances in Summer League and the G League, spending time with Miami, Washington, and Milwaukee before joining the Clippers.

The Clippers (35–15), currently sitting second in the Western Conference, add Antetokounmpo to a core that includes Kawhi Leonard, Paul George, James Harden, and Russell Westbrook as the team pursues its first NBA championship.

“We thank Trentyn, Cam, and Kobe for their hard work, professionalism, and contributions to the Clippers,” Frank added. “They are talented young players with bright futures, and we wish them the very best in Milwaukee.”

Antetokounmpo will join the Clippers immediately and is expected to be available for the team's next game on February 11 against the Phoenix Suns at Crypto.com Arena.
